Congratulations to your graduating senior! I am writing to confirm that the graduation ceremony for the Class of 2019 is Saturday, June 1st at 11:00am.

Seniors will have their last day of classes on Wednesday, May 29. During the day, they will attend all classes, finish required course work, pay any remaining fees or fines and obtain signature for their checkout form. All seniors must return to school on Friday, May 31st at 10:00am for graduation practice. The seniors will be dismissed from school after completing the checkout and practice.

On Saturday, June 1, the seniors need to be wearing their caps and gowns and seated in the bleachers for the senior group picture at 10:15a.m. Graduation is a formal occasion for honoring graduating seniors as they transition to the next phase of their life. Please remind your graduation senior that appropriate dress is requested, we ask that dress not include flips flops, beach sandals, or shorts. Students will be provided with additional instructions during Friday's graduation practice.
