Dear MONTANA High School Career Counselors,

Greetings! My name is Brent Reinhardt and I am the recruiting, admissions and scholarship officer for Montana State University's Army Reserve Officers' Training Corps (ROTC) program. If you have college-bound seniors that are interested in serving in the military as officers after graduating from college, please encourage them to apply for one of the prestigious 4 year national Army ROTC scholarships. These scholarships provide:

100% Tuition (or 100% Room and Board); pay a monthly stipend of \$420/month; and \$1200 yearly for books. Nurse majors receive a \$650 bonus upon entering their junior year. The Army also pays for their study preparation materials and licensing exam.

To apply encourage them to visit <https://www.goarmy.com/rotc/high-school-students/four-year-scholarship.html> High School transcripts and ACT/SAT scores are required to be faxed or scanned, a Presidential Fitness test administered, a medical exam at a local physician (that the Army pays for), and a personal interview conducted at the nearest ROTC program (usually either MSU or UM. If selected, applicants will either be awarded a 4 year national scholarship or a 3 year advanced designee scholarship.

The upcoming boards are in **January 2021 and March 2021**, to select next year's ROTC scholarship winners. So the incoming seniors should hurry if they wish to apply.
